

Completing a Health Risk Assessment (HRA) Within myHealthButton or myHealthPortal and CHAMPS

A key feature of the Healthy Michigan Plan (HMP) is the Healthy Behaviors Incentives Program which encourages HMP managed care members to maintain and implement healthy behaviors. The myHealthButton and myHealthPortal applications can help members complete and submit the Health Risk Assessment (HRA) required by the Healthy Michigan Plan.



Within myHealthButton and myHealthPortal, the member clicks **Health Risk Assessment**.



The member completes **Section 1** through **Section 3** of the HRA.



The HRA Questions screen displays a congratulations message and next steps instructions. To share their HRA with their doctor, the member selects **Share with doctor** and presses **SUBMIT**.*

THE USER'S ROLE



Once the HRA is submitted from myHealthButton or myHealthPortal, it is transmitted to CHAMPS.

HRA IN CHAMPS



After locating the HRA within CHAMPS**, the PCP is required to complete **Section 4** with the patient. The provider must certify that they have examined the patient and the information provided in the HRA is complete and accurate to the best of their knowledge. Once the PCP submits the HRA, it is complete.

THE PRIMARY CARE PROVIDER'S (PCP) ROLE



*Note: Members may also tap **PREVIEW** to view the completed Health Risk Assessment. If a member selected the "Do not share" option and then submits, they can go back and select "Share with doctor" at any time.
