## What are myHealthButton and myHealthPortal?

These applications put health care benefits and services directly into the hands of members that are served by the State of Michigan. myHealthButton is a mobile app that can be accessed from a smartphone or tablet. myHealthPortal is a website that can be accessed from any browser with internet access.

View your Medicaid health information.



Add additional members to the app.



Find a doctor nearby.



View your insurance claims.



View and download your immunization history.



View and update your primary care physician information.



View and request a copy of your mihealth card.



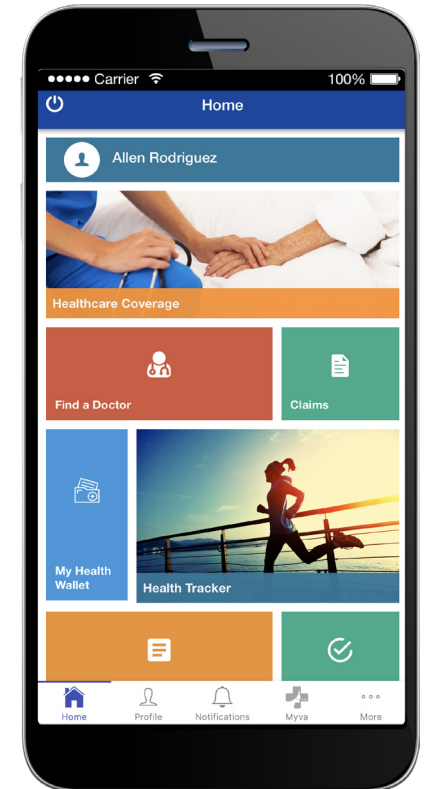
Complete and submit your CSHCS Income Review/Payment Agreement Form.

## Who Can Register?

Members of Michigan Medicaid, the Healthy Michigan Plan, MI Child, and Children’s Special Health Care Services (CSHCS) can access both the myHealthButton and myHealthPortal applications.

## Gaining Access Is Easy!

By following these simple steps, you can begin to take advantage of all the benefits these apps have to offer.



## What Information Is Needed To Complete Registration?

- Relationship to Member
- Member Full Name
- Member Date of Birth
- Member Residential Address
- Member Valid Michigan Driver’s License or State ID
- Member MIhealth Card ID
- Access to a Text-Message Capable Phone OR Valid Email Address
- Access to a Smartphone with a Working Camera

### Step 1:

If you don’t already have a MILogin account, you can create one here: [milogin.michigan.gov](http://milogin.michigan.gov).

### Step 2:

Log into MILogin and request access to the myHealthPortal application.

### Step 3:

Complete your myHealthPortal registration. You can now access myHealthPortal at [myhbclid.state.mi.us](http://myhbclid.state.mi.us) OR continue to Step 4 to gain access to the myHealthButton app.

### Step 4:

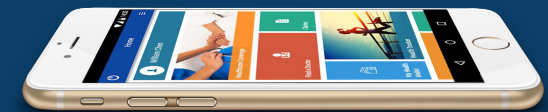
Download the myHealthButton app from Google Play or the Apple App Store.



You must FIRST register with [MILogin](http://milogin.michigan.gov), in order to log into myHealthButton and myHealthPortal.

### Step 5:

Sign into myHealthButton using the same MILogin username and password and myHealthButton for myHealthPortal. Once you’ve logged into either version of the app, you may now link your family members’ accounts.
