



What Are myHealthButton and myHealthPortal?

These applications put health care benefits and services directly into the hands of members that are served by the State of Michigan. myHealthButton is a mobile app that can be accessed from a smartphone or tablet. myHealthPortal is a website that can be accessed from any browser with internet access.



Features Include:



View your Medicaid health information



View and download immunization history



Find a doctor nearby



View and update physician information



Track health and fitness progress



Complete your Health Risk Assessment (HRA)



Add additional members to the app



View and request mihealth card copy



View insurance claims



Complete and submit your CSHCS Income Review/Payment Agreement Form







Who Can Register For These Applications?

Members of Michigan Medicaid, the Healthy Michigan Plan, MIChild, and Children's Special Health Care Services (CSHCS) can access both the myHealthButton and myHealthPortal applications.

What Information Is Needed To Complete Registration?

- ✓ Relationship to Member
- ✓ Member Full Name
- ✓ Member Date of Birth
- ✓ Member 7IP Code
- ✓ Member mihealth Card ID
- ✓ Access To a Text Message Capable Phone <u>OR</u> Valid Email Address

Step 1:

If you don't already have a MILogin account, you can create one here:

milogin.michigan.gov

Step 2:

Log into MILogin and request access to the myHealthPortal application.

Step 3:

Complete your myHealthPortal registration:

- Check your e-mail or text messages for a temporary PIN.
- Enter your temporary PIN and create a new PIN when asked.
- Click Submit.

You can now access myHealthPortal at https://myhbcld.state.mi.us OR continue to Step 4 to gain access to the myHealthButton app.

Step 4:

Download the myHealthButton app from Google Play or the Apple App Store.





You must <u>FIRST</u> register with <u>MILogin</u>, in order to log into myHealthButton and myHealthPortal.

Step 5:

Sign into myHealthButton using the same MILogin username and password and myHealthButton PIN as for myHealthPortal. Once you've logged into either version of the app, you may now link your family members' accounts.
